Holiday Concerts

This year we will be having our holiday concerts on Dec 6 (evening) & 7 (daytime).

<u>Dec 6</u> there will be **two** evening performances. Our first performance begins at **5:30pm** for these classes: **PW**, **1T**, **2H**, **3/4W** and **4/5A**. Our second evening performance begins at **7:00pm** for **P/1G**, **1/2C**, **2/3WC/VP**, **3/4D**, **5B**.

<u>Dec 7</u> Our first daytime performance begins at **9:00am** for these classes: **PW, 1T, 2H, 3/4W and 4/5A.** The second daytime performance begins at **11:00am** for **P/1G, 1/2C, 2/3WC/VP, 3/4D, 5B.**

The evening performances are for parents (2 tickets per family will be sent home with the youngest child). The daytime performances are where other family members (grandparents, etc) are welcome to attend. The morning performances will not require a ticket. Doors will open at 5:10pm for 5:30pm performance and 6:40 for 7pm performance. Students in the concert should go to their classrooms when they arrive. Each person attending the evening concerts will require a ticket, this includes any small children sitting on laps. The winners of the front row tickets will be notified as soon as the draw has taken place. **Tickets for the evening concerts will be sent home on Tuesday, Dec 5th.**
